- ✓ 2 nominators
- ✓ 3 (minimum) to 5 (maximum) letters of support
  - Letters may be included with this material or forwarded directly, please include a list of all those who will be supplying letters of support.
  - Letters of support must detail contribution to the work of the Centre, and/or, how their life and ministry has honoured the Centre, and/or how their work epitomizes the ideals of the Centre
- ✓ a biography of the nominee - including personal history, education, employment, volunteer work indication of why this nominee should be considered detailing their contribution to the work of the Centre, and/or, how their life and ministry has honoured the Centre, and/or how their work epitomizes the ideals of the Centre.
