

## Emma Kaufman Scholarship

The Kaufman Scholarship, was a gift of the late Emma Kaufman, the income to be used to make possible study, observation and experience outside the North American continent. It has been awarded to a university graduate or to someone with demonstrated equivalency. Preference will be given to a woman.

Terms for the Trust as approved at the annual meeting of The Centre for Christian Studies Canada, Inc., March 16, 2000:

1. A scholarship for study or a learning experience outside of Canada or The United States for an extended period of time. It will be awarded to someone with a university degree or demonstrated equivalency. Applicants must demonstrate commitment to a theology of social justice. Preference will be given to women applicants.
2. The capital will be invested in perpetuity and only the interest is available for award.
3. Costs of administering and advertising the Scholarship may be provided out of the interest earnings.
4. Thirty (30) percent of the interest earnings in each year be added to the existing capital. The balance of earnings each year will be available for disbursement for bursaries as needed. Any unused disburseable funds will accrue to be disbursed in future years.
5. The terms of this trust may be amended at a duly called and held meeting of the Corporation of the Centre for Christian Studies Canada Inc.
6. Should the Centre for Christian Studies continue, but in a new form as the result of amalgamation, or otherwise, then this trust would continue with the Centre in the new form. In the event that the Centre for Christian Studies Canada Inc., might cease to exist entirely, the capital and any unspent disburseables shall be divided evenly between the United Church of Canada and The Anglican Church of Canada, to be held in trust for disbursement to theological students, in a manner in keeping with the spirit and intent of the terms lastly defined by the Centre for Christian Studies Canada Inc.
