

Centre for Christian Studies Use of Alcohol Policy

Policy

- 1) both wine and grape juice will be available and clearly identified at all Eucharist/ Communion services at CCS.
- 2) Woodsworth House will be alcohol free at all times, with the exceptions of agreed upon options of wine or grape juice for Eucharist/Communion, and the CCS management having discretion to negotiate with renters for specific occasions.
- 3) all functions, with the exception of Eucharist/Communion, where CCS gathers as a formal body (e.g. for learning circles, retreats, or meetings) outside Woodsworth House, will be alcohol free.
- 4) at CCS functions outside of Woodsworth House that are open to people other than CCS (e.g. fund raising events, celebrations, recognition events), alcohol may be made available.
- 5) if alcohol is available at the above events, non-alcoholic beverages will also be available; both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages be clearly identified; and beverages be available at a specific serving site(s) or by placing an order and NOT be served automatically to every table.
- 6) individuals representing CCS at other events and meetings are free to choose whether or not to use alcoholic beverages.

Note: the term “CCS” includes staff, students, members of the Central Council, its committees and task and working groups.
